A Meditation On The Gift

As unmarried covenant believers, we have probably read (or at least heard of) 1 Corinthians 7. In Apostle Paul's letter, Paul teaches about singleness and the “gift”. Since the chapter opens with direct concerns about sex (who can have it, when one should have it, and under what circumstances), we as believers may have mentally reduced the “gift” to an underwhelming, unsuper human power to abstain from “it” - sex, that is. Although I would not build doctrine

upon it, the Message Bible's paraphrasing provokes wonderful revelatory possibilities about this same gift: “Sometimes I wish everyone were single like me—a simpler life in many ways! But celibacy is not for everyone any more than marriage is. God gives the gift of the single life to some, the gift of married life to others” (1 Cor 7:7 MSG). Beyond Paul's personal vote, he depicts singleness and marriage as fairly equal. They are both gifts. Moreover, in the Message wording, both conditions hinge on one

thing-life. Could this be the same John 3:16 life that Christ gave us? ...that overcoming, victorious thrilling yet frustration miracle working, authority having, joy filled, tear producing, peace loving, hell charging taking-care-of-business-like-a-boss life that we choose to have. The answer is YES and as the New Testament Seed of Abraham, we do choose “it”-life, that is (Deut 30:15-19).
